


Share knowledge

Get early feedback



- Spelling, punctuation & grammar

- Fit with the overall architecture
- New code follows team's current practices
- Code is in the right place
- Code reuse
- Testing the right things
- Readable code and tests
- SOLID principles, Domain Driven Design
- Design Patterns or other paradigms of choice


